










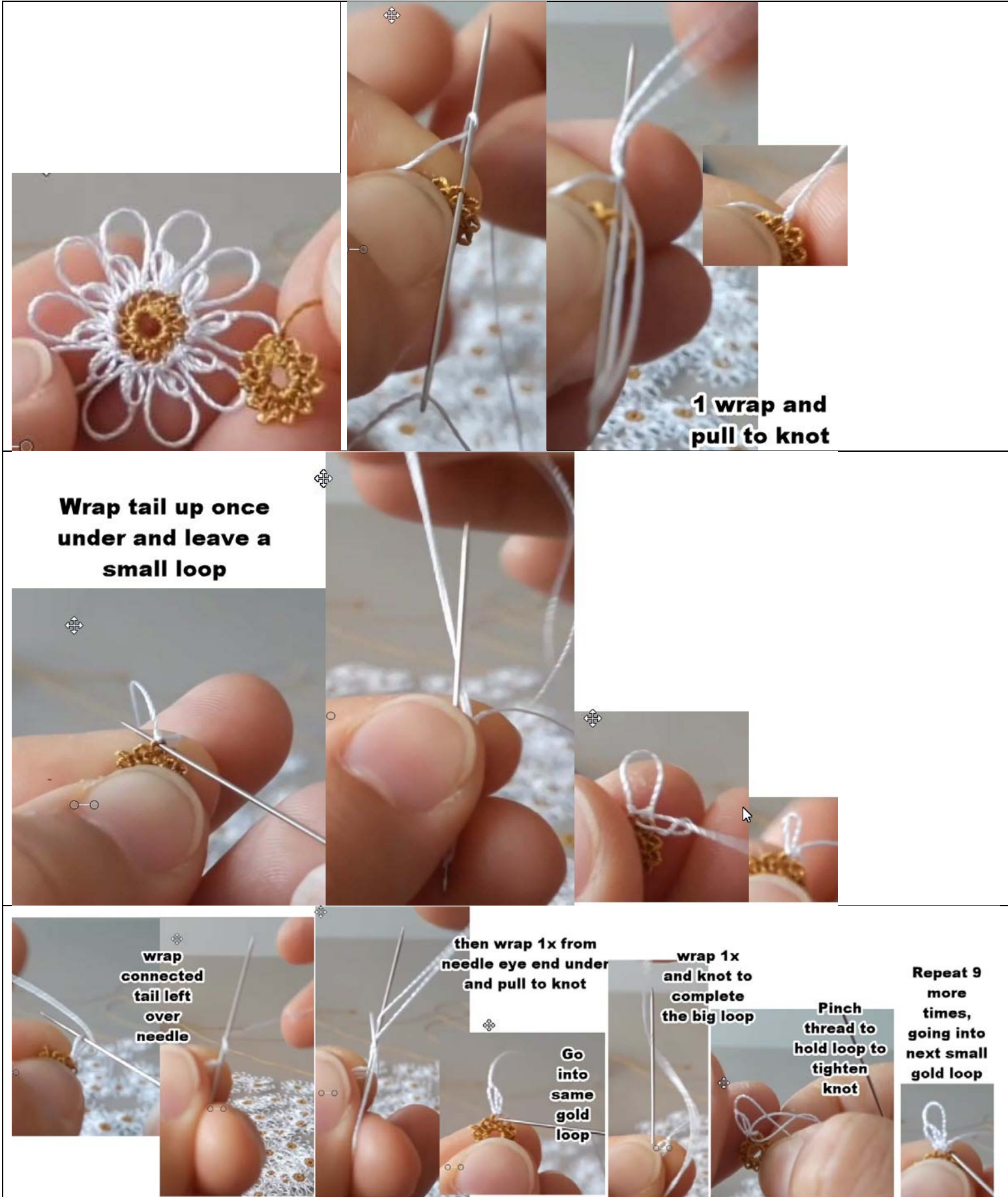
Daisy Oya instruction from this YouTube site:

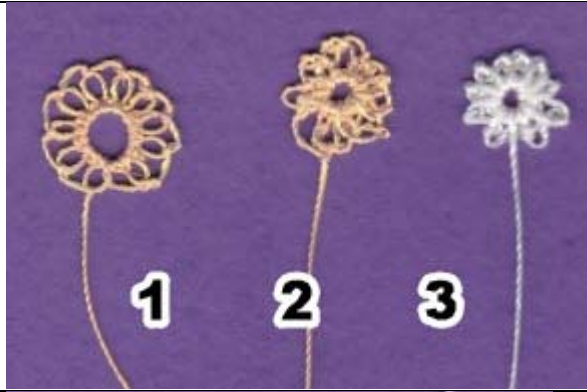

1. Create gold center (2 rows, 10 loops off a center ring):

		<p>Polyester thread or Lizbeth size 10 (probably)</p> 	
			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wrap gold thread around Q-tip or gage and needle 6 times.</li> <li>• Wrap end of thread up between the gage/needle</li> <li>• Bring up eye end of thread between the gage/needle pull up the needle and tighten.</li> </ul>
			<p>Center gold is 2 rows. Make 10 small loops.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Insert needle into center of the ring.</li> <li>• Connected end of thread is over the needle</li> <li>• Bring needle eye end of thread up and under 1x, pull through to make a tight knot.</li> <li>• Repeat 9 times more for the first row; repeat around only go into the loops you just made.</li> <li>• Cut.</li> </ul>

## 2. Create 10 daisy petals in white:





Size 50 Poly turkish thread:

1. Tatted ring **10x(1ds 1p) cls** and 1 round Oya
2. Two rounds Oya
3. Slightly heavier poly thread, 2 rounds



White poly thread (Leather Machine Co. 138  
Nylon bonded ½ lbs white)
